**CATEGORIES AND TOPICS**

**1. ASSIGNED COLOR AND MONOCHROME:**

**September: Human Body Parts** – Any part or parts of a body, NO full torsos. NO frontal nudity. NO obscenity. NO clothes, drapes, etc.

**October: Reflections** - The subject of the photo must be shown as a reflection from any reflective surface (for example: glass, mirror, shiny metal, water, etc.). The surface is not the subject what is reflected is the subject.

**November: Make Me Laugh** – Funny photos.

**December: Nighttime** – Any photos of any subjects taken outside after dark with NO flash.

**January: Sussex County DE Architecture** - The practice of designing building structures especially habitable ones. A method or style of building. Queen Anne, Victorian and Gothic Revival are some used in Sussex County. The building does not have to be inhabited at time photo is taken but must have been built for human habitation (not a barn or garage).

**February: Shadows** – The dark figure cast upon a surface by a body or object intercepting the rays from a source of light.

**March: Water** – Liquid that descends from the clouds as rain; forms streams, lakes, seas, puddles, etc. NOT tap or bottled water.

**April: Abstract** – Art that looks as if it contains little or no recognizable or realistic forms from the physical world. Emphasis on colors, lines or shapes.

**2. ASSIGNED NATURE – COLOR AND MONOCHROME: Must be living organisms. NO pets.**  
Definition of nature is: “No Hand of Man” meaning items made by a human cannot be included in the photo.

November: Macro – Insects

December: Farm Animals

January: Water Fowl/Ducks and Waders

February: Macro – Fungus and mushrooms

March: Zoo Animals
