Seeing a finished image displayed online is always a nice feeling but actually holding a physical print gives a completely different type of satisfaction. Making a good print isn't as straightforward as one would think and most of us have experienced that the printed image doesn't look nearly as good as it does on the computer. You need to optimize the image beforehand sending it off to the printer. Tom Schell, Director of Color Management from Nations Photo Lab will teach you how to improve your prints. This program is designed for those who send images out to print, however, there will be great information if you print at home.
