November 2-3, 2024. MAPV is having a photography conference in Manassas, VA at the Hylton Performing Arts Center. Motels/hotels are located nearby.

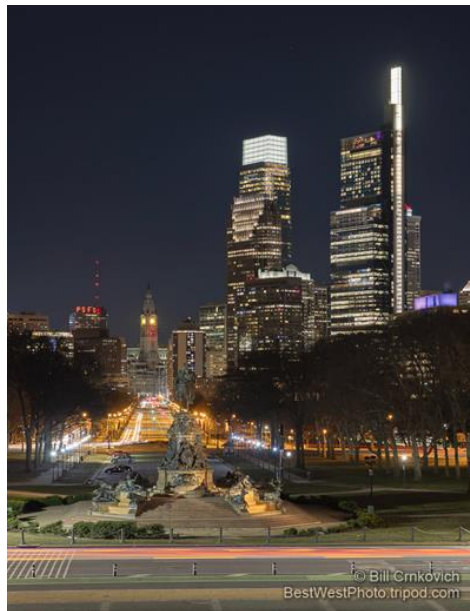
